Ormston House presents an evening of film and conversation with **Denise Chaila** and **B+** at the Belltable Arts Centre.

During **Energy: A Visual Mixtape**, the two Limerick artists will talk about their collaborative practice. They will share the experience of making work together and how their respective practices resulted in connecting Irish and African histories. The event is centred on the short film titled **Energy**, which they wrote and directed in 2021, and which assembles a constellation of ideas and shared research interests. The film eulogizes local spaces including Ardnacrusha Power Station, Mount Trenchard, and People's Park, montaging archival and contemporary footage to form visual couplets marrying diasporan histories, racial discrimination and political ideologies, magic and music.


What happens to children in the absence of love? That is the question that lies at the heart of this funny and heartrending play by one of America's most acclaimed and beloved playwrights.

At the Iron Annie Cabaret, expect all the things that might happen when you combine an unstable relationship with bootlegging booze and selling drugs.

The show tells the tale of Aoife, a force of a woman from Dundalk, and her obsessive love for the charismatic Annie. Think **Reservoir Dogs** meets **Thelma & Louise** meets the **Rocky Horror Picture Show**.

Directed by Peter Moreton, Aoife is brought to life by Eleanor McLoughlin in this unique production. The Iron Annie Cabaret will also feature entirely original music inspired by the book and composed and performed live by folk duo **The Dandelion Few** and border-punk quartet **False Slag**.

Luke Cassidy is a writer from Dundalk. **Iron Annie** is his first novel, first published by Bloomsbury Books (Ire/UK) in September 2021, and by Vintage Books in North America in January 2021.

Two Limerick musical legends come together for an intimate night of music and song in Belltable this November.

Mick Hanley and **Johnny Duhan** songs are now performed worldwide and in a variety of languages. Both Limerick singer songwriters have worked with artists like Christy Moore, Mary Black, The Dubliners, Dolores Keane and a host of others who have championed many of their songs spanning the past 30 years.

They both come together for one night only and reminisce about growing up in Limerick, tell tall tales of the early days of their musical careers, share great stories of working on various albums over the years and collaborating with other Irish musical legends. Each will perform solo for 30 minutes and then for the last 45 minutes both will come together to perform some of their all time favourites.

Currently Mick is recording a new album featuring new songs and some of his favourite covers, He is joined by some of Ireland's most respected musicians, **Donal Lunny, Eoghan O'Neill, Dave Keary, Ray Fean,** and **James Delaney**. The album is due out in Feb 2022.

The second half of the programme takes us on the day's journey into night with a diverse range of pieces inspired by morning, evening and night, including the late Eric Sweeney's homage to the ancient lighthouse at Hook Head in County Wexford, part of the Ros Tapestry Suite.


